Research how to reference using APA format. Correct referencing will present you as a researcher-teacher to the parent community.

Example:

Within the document: "This is a statement I have said" (Sameshima, 2011, p. 34). In the reference section:

Sameshima, P. (2011), *Quotes by the teacher: Everyday sayings*. Pullman, WA: College of Education Press. [Author, Initials. (year). *Book title*. Location, State: Publisher.]
